SUBMISSIONS

Wall hung artwork in any medium may be submitted. To apply, you must submit: (i) this completed form, (ii) a digital file of your artwork not exceeding 10x10" at 140 dri to artshow@gnaonline.org or by CD to the address below (iii) the entry fee via check or online payment. If you choose to mail these items, please see the mailing address below. Please note that the CD and other materials will not be returned.

ENTRY FEE

Entry fees for GNA members are \$25 for one, \$30 for two, \$35 for 3. Fees for non-GNA members are \$30 for one, \$35 for two, \$40 for 3. To submit payment online, please visit **gnaonline.org**.

IDENTIFICATION OF ARTWORK

Artists must identify their work with their names and contact information affixed to backside of each piece that has been chosen, forms enclosed.

JURORS

A jury comprised of art professionals will evaluate the works submitted for consideration and make selections for the GNA exhibition. The jury has the final word on acceptance and rejections.

SALES

Artists may offer their work for sale. GNA will receive a commission of 30%. The artist is responsible for collecting NY City sales tax (8.875%). Sold work must remain on view until the end of the show. Delivery arrangements are the responsibility of the artist.

DELIVERY OF ARTWORK

Artist must deliver work to the National Arts Club at 15 Gramercy Park South, NYC, March 17th between 8 AM and 12 PM.

PICK-UP OF ARTWORK FOLLOWING THE SHOW

No work may be removed before the official end of the show. All work must be picked up on Saturday, March 29th between 9 AM and 12 PM. GNA cannot accept liability for artwork left after the official end of the exhibit.

TYPE & SIZE OF ARTWORK

Maximum framed size is 32x32" (or 1,024"²).

ARTWORK MUST BE READY FOR HANGING

Only professionally presented work with the proper hardware will be accepted. Saw tooth hangers will be rejected. All work must be wall mounted. No pedestals.
